ACCOMMODATION



The Al Andalus Train has two types of accommodation.

The Deluxe Suite. A spacious, elegant suite, consisting of a bedroom and private bathroom, perfectly suited for rest and privacy. It features a large bed that becomes a comfortable sofa during the day.

The spacious and comfortable bathroom has a shower, hairdryer and a varied set of welcome items and toiletries. A safe, minibar, wardrobe, luggage rack and individually controlled air conditioning are other 21st century comforts that, in this suite, go hand in hand with the historic train's original appearance. The train features 20 Deluxe Suites.

The Gran Clase Room. This cosy room, which has a private bathroom, features the same size and atmosphere of the original compartments.

It has two single beds that become comfortable armchairs during the day, as well as a minibar, safe, wardrobe, luggage rack and adjustable air conditioning. Its functional private bathroom makes the most of the space, being equipped with a shower, hairdryer and a varied set of welcome items and toiletries. The train has 12 Gran Clase Rooms.



COMMON LOUNGES



The Al Andalus Train features four railway gems, its four lounge cars from 1928 and 1930.

These common areas are intended for leisure and the pleasure of travelling on the largest and most spacious luxury train, while enjoying buffet breakfast, lunch or dinner on board, relaxing with a drink, listening to musical performances, contemplating the scenery or simply chilling out in the comfortable armchairs.

All the cars have air conditioning and are open 24 hours a day for your use and enjoyment.

Restaurant cars, bar car, tea room, all at your disposal, as well as the service of the crew along with your Trip Supervisor and accompanying guides.







ITINERARY



From Seville to Granada

DAY 1: Seville – Jerez

Reception of passengers at 10:00 a.m. at the hotel in Seville and tour of the city. Lunch in a restaurant and, in the afternoon, welcome toast on the train. Crew presentation and settling in. Dinner and overnight stay on board.

DAY 2: Jerez – Cádiz – Jerez

After our first breakfast on board, we will depart with our coach to visit Cadiz. Lunch in Sanlúcar de Barrameda and tour of a winery. In the afternoon, return to Jerez. Free time, dinner and overnight stay in Jerez.

DAY 3: Jerez – Ronda

After breakfast, we will enjoy a tour and the show *“How the Andalusian Horses Dance”*. Lunch in Puerto de Santamaria. Dinner on board and overnight stay in Ronda.

DAY 4: Ronda – Córdoba

After breakfast, we will visit Ronda and its famous bullring. Lunch in a restaurant. Dinner on board and overnight stay in Cordoba.

DAY 5: Córdoba – Úbeda – Baeza – Granada

After breakfast on board, we will visit the Cathedral-Mosque and continue touring Cordoba. Lunch in a restaurant. We will then travel to Úbeda; tour of the town, which is a World Heritage Site. Next, we will visit an oil press, where olive oil is produced. In the evening, while enjoying dinner on board, we will arrive in Granada. Overnight stay in Granada.

DAY 6: Granada

After breakfast, we will visit Spain’s most popular monument, the Alhambra. Lunch in a restaurant. In the afternoon, we will continue touring Granada or free time. Dinner on board and end-of-trip party. Overnight stay in Granada.

DAY 7: Granada

After enjoying our last breakfast on board, we will say goodbye to the train and make a last visit to the Nasrid city. Lunch on board, farewell to the crew and end of the experience.



From Granada to Seville



DAY 1: Granada

Reception of passengers at 10:00 a.m. in a hotel in the city of Granada. Visit to Granada and lunch in a city restaurant. In the afternoon, welcome and settling in on board the Al Andalus Train. Dinner on board and overnight stay in Granada.

DAY 2: Granada – Linares/Baeza

After our first breakfast on board, visit to the Alhambra in Granada. Lunch in a restaurant. In the afternoon, we will continue touring Granada. Dinner on board as the train arrives in Espeluy, where we will spend the night.

DAY 3: Linares/Baeza – Úbeda – Baeza – Córdoba

After breakfast, tour of the town of Úbeda, declared a World Heritage Site. Next, we will visit an oil press, where olive oil is produced. While having lunch on board, the train will arrive in Córdoba. Tour. Dinner in a restaurant and overnight stay in Córdoba.

DAY 4: Córdoba – Ronda

After breakfast on board, we will visit Córdoba and its Cathedral-Mosque, then travel by train to Ronda. Lunch on board. Tour. Dinner in a restaurant and overnight stay in Ronda.

DAY 5: Ronda – Jerez

During breakfast, the train will arrive in Jerez, where we will visit a winery and also enjoy the show “How the Andalusian Horses Dance.” Lunch in Sanlúcar de Barrameda. Dinner on board the train. Overnight stay in Jerez.

DAY 6: Jerez – Cádiz – Jerez

After breakfast, our coach will take us to Cadiz to tour the city. Lunch in Puerto de Santamaría. In the afternoon, return to Jerez. Dinner on board and farewell party. Overnight stay in Jerez.

DAY 7: Seville

During breakfast, we will arrive in Seville for a tour of the city. Lunch on board, farewell to the crew and end of the experience.
