North Route

SAN SEBASTIAN -> SANTIAGO DE COMPOSTELA (8d/7n)

Day 1. San Sebastián - Bilbao - Carranza (Saturday)

Meeting point in San Sebastian at 1.00pm. Tour of the city and lunch. Our luxury coach will then take us to Bilbao, where El Transcantábrico Gran Lujo will be waiting for us. Welcome and settling in. Dinner on board and overnight stay in Carranza.

Day 2. Carranza - Bilbao - Santander (Sunday)

We will begin every day by enjoying our delicious à la carte and buffet breakfast. El Transcantábrico will bring us back to Bilbao to tour this dynamic city, which has managed to reinvent itself after the decline of its traditional heavy industry. The tour includes a visit to the famous Guggenheim Museum, the symbol of this new Bilbao. Return to the train to savour lunch while heading towards Santander. Tour of the elegant capital of Cantabria and free time to explore it at our leisure. Dinner and overnight stay in Santander.

Day 3. Santander – Potes – Comillas - Cabezón de la Sal (Monday)

After breakfast, our coach will take us to Potes, going through the impressive gorge called Desfiladero de la Hermida. After touring this charming Cantabrian town, we can enjoy a thermal circuit in La Hermida Spa. Lunch. In the afternoon, we will visit El Capricho, in Comillas, a marvellous, colourist 19th-century villa designed by Antonio Gaudí. Dinner and overnight stay on board the train in Cabezón de la Sal.

Day 4. Cabezón de la Sal – Santillana del Mar - Llanes (Tuesday)

We will visit Santillana del Mar with its magnificently preserved medieval district. Visit The Altamira Neocave, a museum and faithful reproduction of the maximum exponent of rock art in the Upper Palaeolithic. Lunch on board, we will enter to the region of Asturias as far as Llanes. Dinner and overnight stay in Llanes.

Day 5. Llanes-Picos de Europa-Oviedo (Wednesday)

After breakfast we will go by coach to the heart of the National Park of Picos de Europa. National Park of Picos de Europa. We will visit the Enol Lake and later we will go to the Sanctuary of Covadonga, a sacred place full of tradition and legend. Return to El Transcantábrico for lunch on board while we travel to Oviedo, capital of the Principality of Asturias and an exponent of the Asturian pre-Romanesque style with gems such as San Julián de los Prados such as San Julián de los Prados. Visit, dinner and night in Oviedo.

Day 6. Oviedo-Gijón-Luarca (Thursday)

BILBAO -> SANTIAGO DE COMPOSTELA (6d/5n)

1st Day (Saturday) Bilbao – Laredo - Santoña - Santander

Reception at the Bilbao - Concordia station at 10:00 AM on board the train, introduction of the Crew and accommodation. Panoramic view of the city and visit to the Guggenheim Museum. Lunch on board while the train departs for Treto. By coach, we will approach to visit the old town of Laredo. Boat ride through the bay to Santoña. Visit to an anchovy canning factory in Santoña. Once again by train, we will arrive in Santander, have a panoramic view of the city, and dinner at a restaurant. Night in Santander.

2nd Day (Sunday) Santander - Santillana del Mar - Llanes

While we have breakfast on board the train, we will arrive at Cabezón de la Sal, where our coach will take us to visit the medieval town of Santillana del Mar and the neo-cave of Altamira. SEVILLA -> MADRID (7d/6n)

Day 1. (Sunday) Sevilla - Córdoba

Reception of passengers at 10:00 a.m. at a location to be determined in Sevilla and tour of the City. Afterward, we'll visit the capital of Andalusia, which boasts the largest historic center in Spain. After lunch, we'll enjoy a panoramic view of the city before boarding the Al Andalus Train. We'll receive a welcome toast on the train, introduce the crew, and settle in. Dinner will be served on board as the train heads to Córdoba. Overnight stay in Córdoba.

Day 2. (Monday) Córdoba – Cádiz – Jerez

After breakfast on board, we'll visit the Mosque-Cathedral and continue touring what was once the capital of the medieval Emirate and Caliphate of Al-Andalus, when it was the largest, most cultured, and most opulent city in Western Europe. Lunch will be served on board on route to Jerez. From Jerez, in the afternoon, we'll visit Cádiz, popularly known as the "Silver Cup" and considered the oldest city in the Western World. Dinner in Cádiz and overnight stay in Jerez.

Day 3. (Tuesday) Jerez - Zafra

After breakfast, we'll enjoy the city of Jerez and the show "How the Andalusian Horses Dance," a famous equestrian ballet with Spanish music. Lunch will be served at a local restaurant before visiting a winery in the afternoon. Dinner will be served on board while the train heads to Zafra. Overnight stay in Zafra.

Day 4. (Wednesday) Zafra – Cáceres - Mérida

While we have breakfast, the train will arrive in Cáceres, a World Heritage Site, where the streets, squares, and palaces are magnificently preserved, thanks to its cultural mix that makes Cáceres a unique cultural experience. Lunch will be served on board as we arrive in Mérida, where we will relive the ancient Roman Empire. Also a World Heritage Site, founded in 25 BC, we will visit its remains and history. Dinner and overnight stay in Mérida.

Day 5. (Thursday) Mérida – Alcázar de San Juan

While we have breakfast, the train will arrive in Alcázar de San Juan, located in the region of Castilla-La Mancha, internationally known for its cheeses and wines. We will visit an artisanal cheese factory and a winery. Lunch will be served in the area. In the afternoon, we will visit Campo de Criptana, with its characteristic landscape of windmills, a source of inspiration for Cervantes in his novel Don Quixote. We will return to Alcázar de San Juan, have dinner on board, and spend the night in this town.

Day 6. (Friday) Alcázar de San Juan – Toledo - Aranjuez

While we have breakfast, the train will arrive in Aranjuez. From here, we will visit Toledo, another World Heritage city, which we will consider the most monumental Imperial city in Europe. The blend of Christian, Muslim, and Jewish architecture—the Gothic cathedral, the 10th-century mosque, and two synagogues—has given Toledo its universal character. Lunch in Toledo. In the afternoon, we will visit the Royal Palace of Aranjuez and its gardens. Also a World Heritage Site, where history and beauty fill every corner of this royal site. Dinner on board and overnight stay in Aranjuez.

Day 7. (Saturday) Aranjuez - Madrid

After enjoying our last breakfast on board, we'll bid farewell to the train and its crew and end the journey in Madrid around 1:30 p.m.

The blend of Christian, Muslim, and Jewish architecture, with its architectural representations—the Gothic cathedral, the 10th-century mosque, and two synagogues—has given Toledo its universal character. Lunch in Toledo and free time before returning to the train in Aranjuez. While we dine on board, the train will arrive at Alcázar de San Juan. Overnight stay in Alcázar de San Juan.

Day 3. (Tuesday) Alcázar de San Juan – Cáceres

After breakfast, we'll visit how two of the most famous products of this La Mancha region, internationally known for its cheeses and wines, are produced. We'll visit an artisanal cheese factory and a wine cellar. Lunch will be served in the area. In the afternoon, we'll visit Campo de Criptana, with its characteristic windmill landscape, a source of inspiration for Cervantes in his work Don Quixote. We'll return to Alcázar de San Juan, from where we'll depart by train, having dinner, to reach Cáceres. Overnight stay in Cáceres.

Day 4. (Wednesday) Cáceres – Mérida –Jerez

After breakfast on board, we'll visit Cáceres, a World Heritage City, where the streets, squares, and palaces are magnificently preserved, thanks to its cultural mix that makes it a unique cultural experience. Later, we'll arrive by train for lunch in Mérida. In the afternoon, we'll visit this city of the ancient Roman Empire, also a World Heritage City, founded in 25 BC, where we'll explore its remains and history. While we dine on board, the train will depart for Jerez. Overnight stay in Jerez de la Frontera.

Day 5. (Thursday) Jerez de la Frontera

After breakfast, we'll enjoy the city and the show "How the Andalusian Horses Dance," a famous equestrian ballet set to Spanish music. Lunch will be served at a local restaurant, followed by an afternoon visit to a popular winery. Dinner on board and overnight stay in Jerez.

Day 6. (Friday) Jerez – Cádiz – Córdoba

After breakfast, we'll depart for Cádiz, popularly known as the "Silver Cup" and considered the oldest city in the West. Lunch will be served on board before the train arrives in Córdoba, where we'll visit its Mosque-Cathedral and continue our tour of what was once the capital of the medieval Emirate and Caliphate of Al-Andalus, when it was the largest, most cultured, and opulent city in Western Europe. Dinner and overnight stay in Córdoba.

Day 7. (Saturday) Córdoba - Sevilla

After our final breakfast as we arrive in Seville, we'll bid farewell to the train and its crew. We'll visit Seville, home to the largest historic center in Spain. A World Heritage City, it boasts a wealth of art and beautiful gardens. The journey will end around 1:30 p.m.

BILBAO -> LEON (3d/2n)

Day 1. (Friday) Bilbao – Frias – Espinosa de Los Monteros

Luggage check-in at 14:00 h in Bilbao's La Concordia Station. At 15:00 h, reception of the entire group on board the train. After settling in, El Expreso de La Robla will set off for Espinosa de Los Monteros. We will take our coach to visit the town of Frías and the Tobera Waterfall. Dinner and overnight stay in Espinosa de los Monteros, a beautiful town in Burgos Province's Las Merindades region.

Day 2. (Saturday) Espinosa de Los Monteros - Románico Palentino – Cistierna

While enjoying our first breakfast on board, the train will take us to Mataporquera. From here, we will travel by coach to some magnificent spots on Palencia's Romanesque Route that forms part of the Camino de Santiago; Carrión de los Condes, Fromista, and Saldaña. We will tour this locality and enjoy some free time before going on to visit the Canal of Castile and Romanesque Church of San Martín. Free time and lunch. In the afternoon, we will continue to travel back in time by visiting the Roman town of La Olmeda and its magnificent mosaic collection. Back on board the train, El Expreso de La Robla will take us to Cistierna, where we will have dinner and spend the night.

Day 3. (Sunday) Cistierna – San Feliz – Leon

While we have breakfast, El Expreso de La Robla will take us to San Feliz. From there we will travel by coach to the city of Leon. Tour of its old town, San Isidoro, and the Cathedral. Free time and lunch, to end the trip at approximately 4:00 p.m.

LEON -> BILBAO (3d/2n)

Day 1. (Friday) León – San Feliz – Valporquero – Cistierna

Group reception at 10:00 p.m. After lunch, our bus will take us to San Feliz where El Expreso de La Robla will be waiting for us. Presentation of the crew and transfer to Matallana. From here our coach will take us through the spectacular Hoces de Vegacervera gorge to Valporquero, where we can visit the wonderful caves famous for their stalactites, stalagmites, and outflows of fanciful shapes as well as the impressive 100,000 m³ underground chamber called the Gran Rotonda. We will then return to the train to head towards Cistierna, where we will have dinner and spend the night.

Day 2. (Saturday) Cistierna – Románico Palentino – Espinosa de Los Monteros

While enjoying our first breakfast on board the train, we will travel to Guardo, in the province of Palencia. From there we will travel by coach to visit the Roman town of La Olmeda, with its magnificent mosaic collection, before discovering one of the best ensembles of Romanesque art in Europe that forms part of the Camino de Santiago. Saldaña, Carrión de los Condes, and Fromista, where we will have lunch. After visiting the Church of San Martín and the Canal of Castile, we will return to the train and head towards Espinosa de los Monteros, a beautiful town in Burgos Province's Las Merindades region; dinner and overnight in Espinosa.

Day 3. (Sunday) Espinosa de los Monteros – Bilbao

While having breakfast, we will go through the incredible landscape of the Mena Valley before coming to Bilbao. Tour of the city and its world-renowned Guggenheim Museum. Free time before our trip ends around 14:00 h.

OVIEDO – OVIEDO (6d/5n)

Day 1 (Wednesday) Oviedo - Viveiro

Baggage collection from 14:00 h. to 15:00 h. on the 1st floor of the Renfe station (Ticket Offices-FEVE). 16:30h guided tour of Oviedo, including the Cathedral and the Holy Chamber. Welcome on board, presentation of the crew and accommodation. Catering dinner on board, while the train heads for Galicia. Night as we move to Viveiro.

Day 2 (Thursday) Viveiro

Early arrival in Viveiro. We start the morning as every day enjoying a delicious breakfast buffet. After breakfast, transfer to Ferrol by coach for the pilgrims who wish to walk the first stage; Ferrol – Pontedeume (26 Km.). For those who do not want to walk, coach ride to the northernmost point of the Iberian Peninsula, the Estaca de Bares cape, later visiting the Beach of Bares and O Barqueiro, with free time for lunch. In the afternoon, transfer of the visitors to the train, on the other hand, pick up the walkers in Pontedeume to return to Viveiro. Free time for dinner and night on board in Viveiro.

Day 3 (Friday) Viveiro – Ortigueira

As we have breakfast, the train will move to Ortigueira. From here by coach, we will bring the Pilgrims to Pontedeume, to start their second stage to Abegondo (31 Km). Visitors will make a tour to the Sanctuary of San Andrés de Teixido and Cedeira, with free time for lunch. In the afternoon, transfer of the visitors to the train and pick up the walkers in Abegondo to return to Ortigueira. Free time for dinner and night in Ortigueira.

Day 4 (Saturday) Ortigueira - Ferrol

While having breakfast, the train will travel to Ferrol, then the coach will bring the pilgrims to the starting point of the third stage: Abegondo - A Calle (25 Km). The rest of the guests will approach A Coruña on the bus where we will spend the morning, enjoying a free time for the lunch. In the afternoon, return to the train in Ferrol. That night we will have dinner together at a typical Pulpería. Overnight in Ferrol.

Day 5 (Sunday) Ferrol – Santiago de Compostela – Oviedo

After breakfast on board, transfer of the pilgrims by coach to A Calle, the beginning of the fourth and final stage, which will allow them to reach Santiago de Compostela (27 Km.). Once in Santiago you will have free time until the afternoon. The rest of the Guests will departure by coach from Ferrol to Santiago de Compostela. Free time in Santiago.

By late afternoon, pilgrims and tourists will get back to the train in Ferrol. While enjoying dinner on board (catering) the train will depart for Oviedo. Overnight on board while moving.

Day 6 (Monday) Oviedo

Early arrival of the train in Oviedo. Breakfast on board and farewell to the crew and the train, ending the journey around 11.00h.
